The Cincinnati Scholar House is an affordable housing community designed to provide a stable living and learning environment for low-income single parents and their dependent children while the parent attends post-secondary classes. While the parents are in school, their children will be enriched by an on-site infant to pre-K child development center. By providing this support, the Cincinnati Scholar House can assist single parents in achieving full-time employment and economic stability. Their mission is to break the cycle of poverty and achieve transformative change through education – two generations at a time.

Initially MAPC helped to fund the facility's outdoor play ground. Since its opening in May 2020, the church has provided volunteers for many activities such as the Halloween Parade, the summer street festival, holiday gift wrapping, and summer safety event. We have grown to know the staff and resident families.
